Player Code of Conduct

All Members are required to adhere to the requirements of the Bowls SA (Bowls Australia) Sports Integrity Framework.

In conjunction with the Bowls SA (Bowls Australia) Sports Integrity Framework, you must meet the following requirements in regard to your conduct during any activity held or sanctioned by Bowls SA, a Member Club, Association or an Affiliated club **and** in your role as a player/participant in any activity held by or under the auspices of Bowls SA, a Member Club, Association or an Affiliate Club.

1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of fellow players, coaches, officials and spectators.
2. Do not tolerate acts of aggression.
3. Respect the talent, potential and development of fellow players and competitors.
4. Care for and respect the equipment provided to you as part of your program.
5. Be frank and honest with your coach and selector concerning illness and injury and your ability to train fully within program requirements.
6. At all times avoid intimate relationships with your coach and/or selector.
7. Conduct yourself in a professional manner relating to language, temper and punctuality.
8. Maintain high personal behaviour standards at all times.
9. Abide by the rules and respect the decision of officials, making all appeals through the formal process and respect the final decisions(s).
10. Be honest in your attitude and preparation to training. Work equally hard for yourself and your team.
11. Cooperate with coaches and officials in the development of programs to adequately prepare you for competition of the highest level.
