

In accordance with the provisions of Rule 24 1.6. of the Constitution it was moved, seconded and carried at the Board of Management meeting held on Wednesday May 28th 2025 that by-law fifteen (15) promulgated on 22nd August 2022 be replaced by this revised by-law and to read;: -

By-Law No. – Fifteen (15)
Temporary Closure of the Club & Access Control for
Member Safety.

This By-law shall only come into effect in the event of natural disaster, emergency, epidemic or pandemic conditions which threaten or have the capacity to threaten the health or safety of members, staff and visitors.

In such conditions, the Board shall have the ability to temporarily:-

1. Close the club;
2. Suspend member access and/or privileges
3. Suspend social bowls and/or night owl competition;
4. Cancel functions due to be held at the club with a full refund of any deposits or fees paid unless the club is unable to recover fees it may have paid to others in relation to the function.

To invoke this By-law, the Board of Management shall notify all members of the specific change in operations by giving written notice (via email and text message) at least twenty four (24) hours prior to their effect. If instructions are given to the Board by Government authorities which do not allow at least twenty four (24) hours notice the Board may act immediately.

In particular reference to the health and safety risks associated with a pandemic or similar event, any appointed club officials are empowered to require the sighting of valid certificates evidencing vaccinations or similar from any individuals who have entered, or wish to enter, our Club facilities, Entry to the Club may be denied if appropriate. Individuals who do not comply with such requests may be reported to relevant authorities as required in line with regulations.
