

Changes to Pennant Conditions of Play

A number of significant changes have been made to the Pennant Conditions of Play for this coming season. They include;

- **Pre-game practice** will be restricted to 30 minutes. Players cannot access the greens until 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start time.
- Thursday games will begin at 10.30am.
- Saturday Divisions 1 & 2 will play without a mid-game break.
- Saturday Divisions 6 & 7 will play 18 ends.
- The method for referencing Bureau of Meteorology forecasts for cancellation of games due to extreme heat has been amended to include the forecast on the day preceding the game.
- Start time for Wednesday rounds 11 to 14 in January will be 10:30 a.m.

These changes are largely as a result of feedback received in the recent Bowls SA pennant survey. Some changes, such as the earlier start time for four of the Wednesday games, are being introduced as a trial. All pennant players, and in particular team managers and umpires, should familiarise themselves with the full conditions of play for 2025/26 which will be available on the Metro Bowls Season Information Page soon.

Night Owls Bowls


During a recent stocktake of our night owls bowls sets, two pairs appear to be AWOL! They look like these ones here.
